

## Xerox Product Response to CERT<sup>®</sup> Advisory CA-2003-04: MS-SQL Server Worm (MS02-061)

The primary audience for this document is Xerox analysts and customers who want information regarding how Xerox products respond to [CERT<sup>®</sup> Advisory CA-2003-04](#), issued by CERT<sup>®</sup> on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2003. The following sections provide excerpts from the CERT<sup>®</sup> advisory and the corresponding Xerox response.

### Background

The CERT<sup>®</sup> Coordination Center (CERT/CC) is a center of Internet security expertise at the [Software Engineering Institute](#), a federally funded research and development center operated by [Carnegie Mellon University](#). CERT<sup>®</sup> studies Internet security vulnerabilities, handles computer security incidents, publishes security alerts, researches long-term changes in networked systems, and develops information and training to help you improve security at your site.

[CERT<sup>®</sup> Advisory CA-2003-04](#) refers to self-propagating malicious code that exploits a vulnerability in the Resolution Service of Microsoft SQL Server 2000 and Microsoft Desktop Engine (MSDE) 2000. This worm is being referred to as the SQLSlammer, W32.Slammer, and Sapphire worm. The propagation of this malicious code has caused varied levels of network degradation across the Internet and the compromise of vulnerable machines.
